SERVICES

- **Teachers:** Instructors selected for their expertise, professionalism and experience (athletic, academic or professional)
- **Academic Counselors:** Pathway planning including course selection, career counselling, NCAA planning, University/college applications, SAT/ACT preparation and student success planning.
- **Social-Emotional Counselors:** Sport-psychology, character development, goal-setting, mindfulness and dedicated wellness counselling.
- **Student Support:** Individual or group support planning, accommodations (environmental, assessment and instructional), executive function planning.
- **Athletic Therapists:** Dedicated treatment, on-site check-ins and consistent follow up.
- **Coaches:** Expert training, specific coaching, health and nutrition, one-on-one counselling / recommendations.



NUANCES OF SECONDARY PLATFORM

- The Grade 8 schedule is based on delivering curriculum in integrated and engaging ways to prepare students for next level.
- Secondary platform is rigorous, university preparatory experience.
- High school credits work towards OSSD and University applications.
- Must balance challenging academics with busy athletic schedule and increasing personal demands.
- Pathway planning can identify personal, professional and academic goals and strategies to meet those goals.
- NCAA eligibility and/or university requirements are intense; our students want more out of their experience and we challenge them with opportunities.



VALUE IS IMPORTANT

- We celebrate our student's experiences - this is integrated into their academic experience.
- We hold students accountable because we care - little things matter.
- Expectations are shared publicly and consistently. We expect students to embrace these expectations and hold their peers accountable to them as well.
- Students are supported to become leaders and mentors, through student-lead experiences.

- November 5 - Letters of Commitment Received
- November 15 - Last day to return LOC to guarantee enrollment for 2025-26. Deposit of \$3,000 required.
 - December 15 - Take advantage of 5% off tuition (less discounts) when all 2025-26 fees are paid in full by December 15.
 - January 15 - Take advantage of 3% off tuition (less discounts) when all 2025-26 fees are paid in full by January 15.
 - February 15 - Take advantage of 2% off tuition (less discounts) when all 2025-26 fees are paid in full by February 15.
